## TRANSPORT:

**By Train:** to Reading Station and then by direct bus shuttle from outside the front of Reading Station. Frequent services run for a 2 hour period prior to kick off. After the match there may be queues for the return.

**By Road:** from Junction 11 of the M4, follow signs towards Reading. The Madejski Stadium is on your left hand side after less than a mile

**Disabled Parking:** there are a limited number of disabled car parking spaces available at the Madejski Stadium which supporters can pre-book by calling 0118 968 1211 or emailing [disability@readingfc.co.uk](mailto:disability@readingfc.co.uk)

## TOWN CENTRE:

Our recommendation to traveling supporters is to make use of town centre car parks (in particular Friar Street) and travel to the Stadium on the special shuttle bus service provided from Reading Station. £3.50 adult return, £2 child return.

## AVAILABLE PARKING:

### Stadium Parking:

Limited Parking at £8. Please note there may be some delays after the final whistle due to priority given to pedestrians.

### Foster Wheeler. Shinfield Park, 500 spaces.

This involves a short bus ride to and from the stadium. Fares for a return shuttle bus apply. **Directions:** From Junction 11, M4 Motorway, take exit B3270 (signposted Earley) and follow signs to "Reading FC Matchday Park & Ride" This is the best option for visiting supporters, £3.50 adult return, £2 child return with free parking.

### Greyhound Stadium, 500 Spaces:

Five minutes walk from Stadium. **Directions:** From Junction 11, M4 Motorway, proceed towards Reading along the A33 dual carriageway, past the Madejski Stadium and past B&Q retail park. Straight ahead at traffic lights on Gyrary roundabout, past Green Park turning and take the next left. Normally full one hour prior to kick off. £8.



Match tickets for AWAY supporters are booked direct from your club in advance. Remaining tickets are sold on the day from the South Stand Ticket Office located between gates 9 and 10 subject to any restrictions in place. Turnstiles open 90 minutes prior to kick off. Food and beverages are available within the Stadium concourses.
