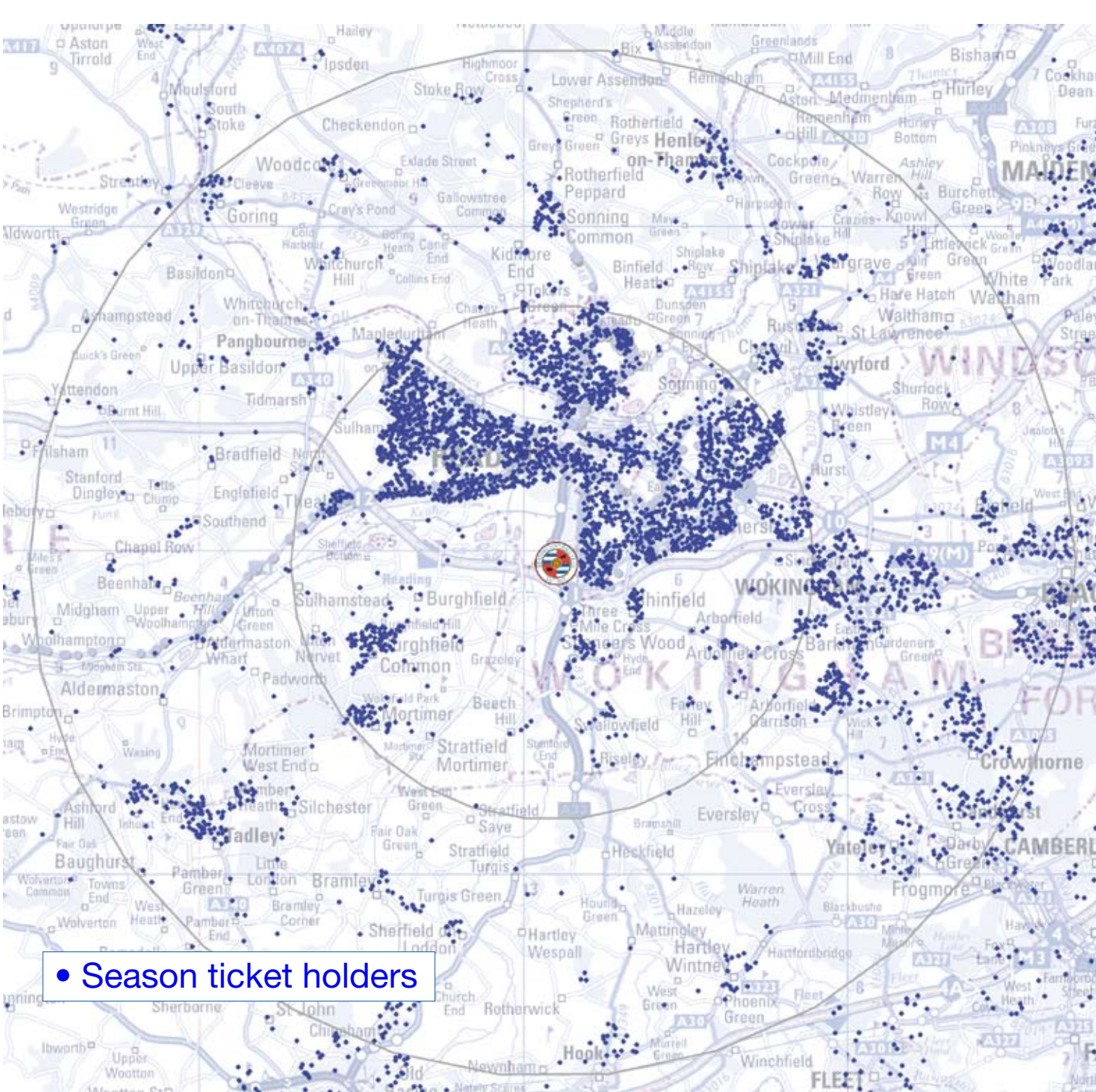




Your Community



The design and development of the stadium will be undertaken with a view to care for, and if possible, improve the surrounding environment.

Safe and efficient transportation of spectators is a key component of the proposal. Increasing parking immediately adjacent to the stadium is not feasible with the current capacity of the A33. Alternative, 'greener' modes of transport are being proposed so that on-site parking will not be increased. These include:

- Increased car sharing
- Increased park and ride services
- More match-day bus services targeting areas of existing supporters
- Concessions on public transport for season ticket holders
- Improved accessibility to the site

An Environmental Impact Assessment will be submitted with the planning application. This work is ongoing and will address the following issues; air quality, noise & vibration, flood risk, ecology, townscape, light pollution, archaeology, soil condition & contamination.
